CRAWFISH BOIL THIS SUNDAY

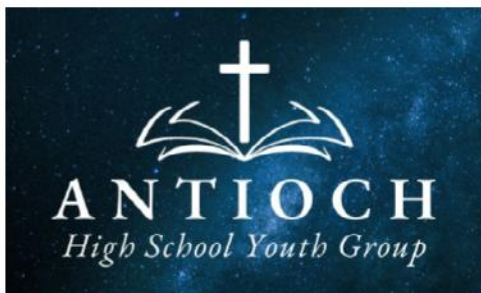

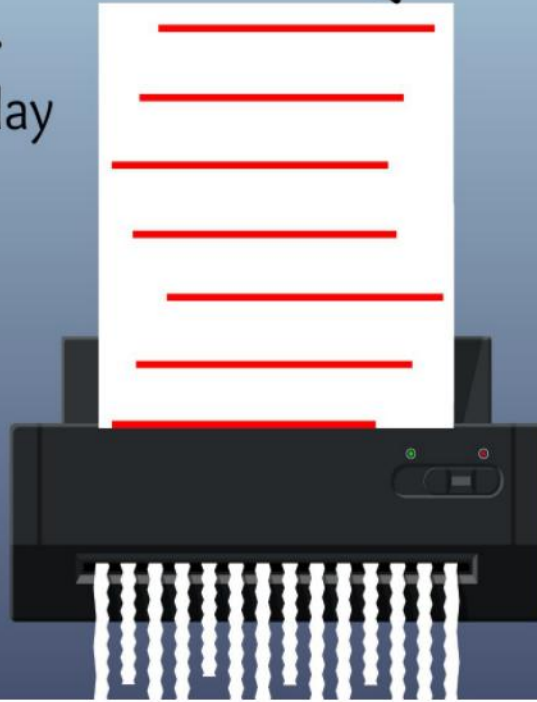

BABY BANKS ARE COMING!

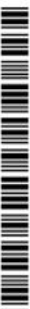

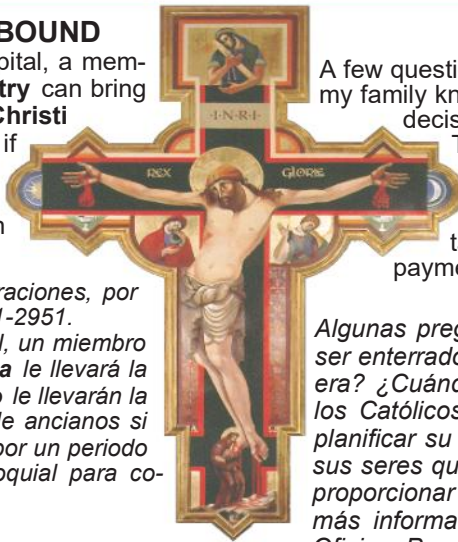


EUCCHARIST FOR SICK OR HOME BOUND

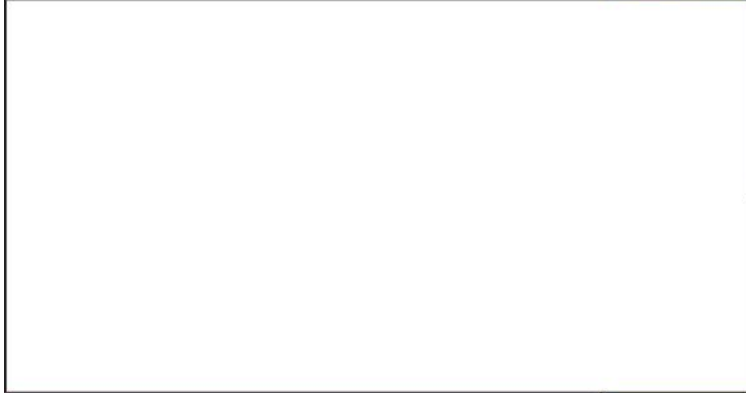
