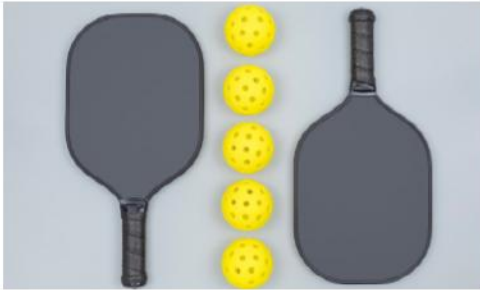

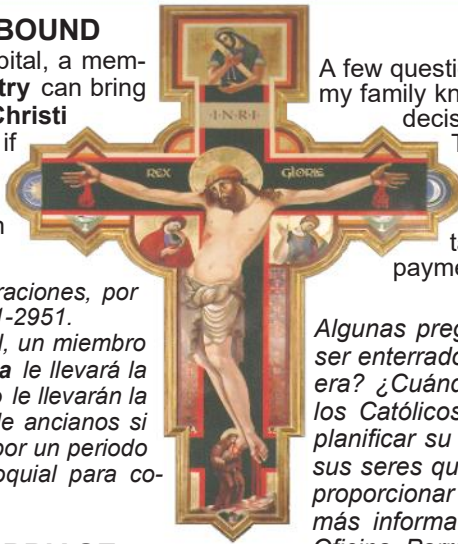


## EUCHARIST FOR SICK OR HOME BOUND
